I don't think that this is a problem except for the possibility of it silting in the existing drainage culvert. There are landscape cloth products available to install at the end of your trench that allow water to pass through while containing the silt before it gets to the culvert. Otherwise, you might be responsible for costs to clean out the culvert filled with your silt.
